

15. Injuries to external genitals.
Indication of purging.

No injuries to external genital.
Rectal prolapse seen.

16. Position of limbs—Especially of arms and of fingers in suspected drowning the presence or absence of sand or earth within the nails or on the skin of hands and feet.

All 4 limbs - straight

17. Surface wounds and injuries.—Their nature, position, dimensions (measured) and directions to be accurately stated—their probable age and causes to be noted.

① Burn patch along with blisters present over Right Upper, middle axillary region extending upto anterior superior iliac spine (Right side)

- If bruises be present what is the condition of the subcutaneous tissues?

② Burn patch with multiple blisters present along lateral aspect of Right thigh - 10 cm x 4 cm

- (N.B.—(When injuries are numerous and cannot be mentioned within the space available they should be mentioned on a separate paper which should be signed).

③ Contusion all over right deltoid region circular 7 cm in diameter

④ Multiple abrasions 1.5 cm x 0.5 cm over Right thigh anteriorly directed horizontally, Red

⑤ Abrasion at base of Rt toe 3 cm x 0.5 cm, Red.

⑥ Abrasion 5 cm horizontal over medial aspect of Right thigh
Fracture of shaft of Right femur. ^{10.5 cm}

8. Other injuries discovered by external examination or palpation as fractures etc.

- (a) Can you say definitely that the injuries shown against serial Nos. 17 and 18 are ante mortem injuries?

Injuries ①, ②, ③, ④, ⑤, ⑥
are ante mortem
