  3. Peri-orbital contusion present over the right eye of size 3cm x 2cm, red in color.
  4. Contused abrasion present over left cheek of size 3x 2cm, red color.
  5. Multiple contused abrasion present over nose, upper lip of size 1x 0.5 cm to 2 x 1cm, all red in color.
  6. Contused abrasion present over the chin on right side size 4x 3cm, red color.
  7. Contused laceration present over the dorsal aspect of left elbow of size 12cm x 4cm x skin deep.
  8. Multiple contused abrasion present on dorsal aspect of right hand over an area of 10 cm x 5cm, of size 2x 1cm to 1 x 1cm, all red in color.
  9. Contused abrasion present over the dorsal aspect of right elbow size 3x 3cm, red color.

1. **Extradural haematoma present over left temporo-parietal lobe of size 100gm.**
  2. **Subdural hematoma present over left temporo-parietal lobe of size 150gm, red color.**
  3. **Subdural hematoma present over occipital lobe of size 120gm, red color.**
  4. **Diffuse subarachnoid hemorrhage present over temporo-parietal and occipital lobes, red color.**

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
