6. Position of limbs -
Especially of arms and

7. Surface wounds and
injuries - Their nature, posi-
tion, dimensions (measured)

probable age and causes
to be noted.

- 1 Surgical intervention seen as stitched wound with 7 stitches, present over occipital region. After opening the stitches lacerated wound of size 8 cm X 2 cm X muscle deep, margins irregular.
- 2 Contusion of size 4x3 cm present over right knee, vertically oblique, bluish.
- 3 Contused abrasion of size 3x3 cm present over left knee, vertically oblique, reddish brown scab.
