**Reason For Admission :**

Patient admitted for local rotation flap cover and splits skin grafting in view of raw area on frontal midline scalp after road traffic accident and avulsion of scalp injury.

**History and Significant Finding :**

General condition moderate, afebrile, pulse rate 62/min, blood pressure 120/80 mmHg, respiratory rate 22/min, SpO2 98% on room air. Respiratory System: Bilateral air entry equal. Cardiac: S1, S2 normal. Abdomen: Soft. Central nervous system: Conscious and oriented. Local Examination: Raw exposed scalp wound approximate 1x1 cm.

**Procedure Performed :**

Local rotation flap cover and split skin grafting done on 09/09/2017. Findings: Raw areas scalp, rotation split skin grafting harvested from left thigh

**Investigation Done :**

**Course In Ward :**

Mr. Tulsidas Dayke is a 31-year-old male patient admitted in Alexis Multispeciality Hospital with above mentioned complaints under Dr. Amol Patel (Plastic Surgeon). Routine investigations were done. Patient underwent rotation flap cover and splits skin grafting on 09/09/2017. Findings mentioned above. Procedure was uneventful. Referral was given to Dr. Nitin Wadaskar (General Physician) and treated accordingly. Patient treated with antibiotics, analgesics and other supportive medications. Patient responded well to treatment, hence is being discharged in stable condition.

**Medication & Treatment :**

Inj Oframax, Inj Amikacin, Inj Dynapar AG, Inj Pan.

**Patient Condition On Discharge :**

Stable.

**Discharge Medications :**

1. Tab Pan 40 mg 1-0-0 before breakfast for 3 days.
2. Tab Augmentin 625 mg 1-0-1 for 3 days.
3. Tab Emanzen-D 1-0-1 for 3 days.
4. Tab Benfomet 100 mg 0-1-0 for 10 days.

**Discharge Medications :**

5. Continue treatment as per Dr. Vishal Bhasme. (Tab. Levipil (500mg) 1-1-1 x 3 months.)


