

15. Injuries to external
genitals.
Indication of purging

No injuries to external genitals noted.
Purging absent.

16. Position of limbs—
Especially of arms and of
fingers in suspected
drowning the presence or
absence of sand or earth
within the nails or on the
skin of hands and feet.

Limbs - semiflexed.

17. Surface wounds and
injuries
Their nature, position,
dimensions (measured)
and directions to be
accurately stated- their
probable age and cause to
be noted.

1. Surgically sutured C shaped incised wound of size 11cm x 0.2cm, sutured with 10 stitches noted over the right temporal region of the scalp. (Evidence of craniotomy).
 2. Abraded contusion of size 2cm x 1cm, brownish in color noted over the left eyebrow, lateral aspect.
 3. Graze abrasion of size 3cm x 1.5cm, brownish in color noted over the left elbow, lateral aspect.
 4. Contusion of size 3cm x 2cm, brownish in color, muscle deep noted over the medial aspect of the right eye.
 5. Injection puncture wounds noted over the cubital fossa bilaterally and over the dorsum of the right hand. (evidence of treatment)
- Description of surface injuries complete.

If bruises be present what
is the condition of the
subcutaneous tissues?

(N.B.—When injuries are
numerous and cannot be
mentioned within the
space available they
should be mentioned on a
separate paper which
should be signed.)

18. Other injuries discovered
by external examination
or palpation as fractures
etc.

No palpable fracture noted over the limbs. Craniotomy as
mentioned in column 19.

a) Can you say definitely that
the injuries shown against
serial nos. 17 and 18 are ante-
mortem injuries?

Yes, antemortem.
