## Allergy:

## Reason For Admission :

Alleged history of dash by a rashly driven 4 wheeler. History of road traffic on 07/11/2018 at about 05:30 am while patient was on morning walk along with his colleagues. Complaints of pain and inability to move right upper and lower limb. Patient is a known case of hypertension, type 2 diabetes mellitus, hypothyroidism.

## Significant Finding :

Pulse 71/min, blood pressure 100/60 mmHg, respiratory rate 24/min, SpO2 100%. GCS 15/15. Pupils NSR. bilateral. Bilateral peri-orbital swelling present. Abraded contusion present over forehead of varying sizes. Respiratory System: Chest clear. Cardiovascular: S1, S2 present. Abdomen: Soft, nontender. CVS: Conscious, oriented. Multiple abrasions present over right knee, right leg lateral aspect and over right ankle area, swelling present over right ankle. Details of all posttraumatic injury sustained by the patient have been enumerated in injury report.

## Surgery or Procedure Performed :

1. Closed reduction with antegrade nailing right ulna, done on 09/11/2018 by Dr. Shivraj Surayawanshi (Orthopedic and Trauma Surgeon).
2. Open reduction internal fixation right medial malleolus with "K" wires and TBW plus distal fibula planting, done on 09/11/2018 by Dr. Shivraj Surayawanshi (Orthopedic and Trauma Surgeon).

## Operation Notes/Procedure Details :

1. In view of large and deep abrasion over posterior forearm, decision taken nail the ulna. In supine position, under general anesthesia, painting and drapping done. Slab incision over olecranon process for entry point of ulna nail. Entry made with oval size 3 mm x 24 cm nail passed in medullary canal of right ulna. Reduction and fixation checked under C-arm and accepted. 1 Wash given. Incision closed. Procedure uneventful. Postop dressing done. 2. In supine position under general anesthesia, tourniquette at 280 mmHg, painting and drapping done. Lateral approach to distal fibula. Fracture exposed and reduced. Hole plate fixed to fibula with proximal and distal screws. Medial curvilinear incision for right medial malleolus, fracture exposed and reduced. 2 "K" wires transfixed. Tension band wiring done with "SS" wires and 1 proximal screws. Final reduction and fixation checked under C-arm and accepted. Wash given. Incision closed in layers. Procedure was uneventful. Postop dressing done.

## Medication &amp; Treatment :

TREATMENT: Mr. Durgeshwar Chaudhari is a 49-year-old male patient came to Alexis Hospital with the above-mentioned complaints and admitted under Dr. Shivraj Surayawanshi (Orthopedics and Trauma Surgeon). Patient was initially taken to Government Hospital at Saoner, received treatment and then brought by relatives to Alexis Hospital for further treatment. Routine investigations done, which showed WBC 15420. CT scan was done, which showed scalp hematoma over right frontal region. Grade abrasion present lateral upset of right elbow and right forearm. Chest x-ray was suggestive of fractured distal 3rd shaft right ulna. X-ray right leg with ankle was suggestive of fractured medial malleolus right tibia, fracture distal 3rd right fibula, nailline fracture distal 3rd right tibia. Referral was given to Dr. Jayant Kelwade (Endocrinologist) in view of type 2 diabetes mellitus who advised and treated accordingly. Dressing done. Patient underwent closed reduction with antegrade nailing right ulna and also open reduction internal fixation right medial malleolus with "K" wires and TBW plus distal fibula planting, on 09/11/2018 by Dr. Shivraj Surayawanshi (Orthopedics and Trauma Surgeon). Procedures were uneventful. After stabilization, patient shifted to ward for further management. Patient was treated with antacids, antibiotics, analgesics, eye drops, multivitamins and other supportive medications. Patient responded well to the given treatment and hence is being discharged home in stable condition. PLC information given to Mankapur police station. All medicolegal formalities completed.
