

Nature of injury of Description of injury (its site & situation over the body)


HEAD INJURY

CT Scan Brain done outside shows s/o multifocal hemorrhagic Contusions in bilateral Temporal lobes, GC region, corona radiate, Thalamus with Sub-Arachnoid Hemorrhage (SAH) with Inter-Ventricular hemorrhage. Mild diffuse cerebral edema present.  
Clinically signs suggestive of Diffuse Axonal Injury (DAI).

FACIAL SURFACE INJURIES

Graze Abrasions present over right side face extending from forehead upto Zygoma of size ~ 3.5 cm x 1.5 cm, also involving helix of right ear pinna. Multiple linear Abrasions present over right cheek and over right mandibular area of varying sizes. Contused Abrasion present over middle 3<sup>rd</sup> area of right lateral aspect of neck of size ~ 3 cm x 2 cm. all surface injuries are in the stage of healing showing reddish brown scab.



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
