Diagnosis: RTA with fracture shaft tibia right with fracture fibula.

Summary: A 30 years old male patient admitted at Neuron Hospital with A/H/O - skidding of bike at Saoner Dhapewada road, 4 pm 31.3.17. took primary treatment at Jiwtode hospital Saoner.
C/O - pain (R) LL eternity restricted movement.

On Examination: GC - moderate, P - 72/min, BP - 130/90 mmHg, RR - 18/min, pupils - equal R2L, RS - chest clear, P/A - soft, CNS - conscious oriented, moving all 4 limbs.

Treatment Given: Inj. Oframax forte, Inj. Amikacin, Inj. Dynapar AQ, Inj. Pan, Inj. Zofer, Inj. Metro, Inj. PCM, Inj. Eldervit, Inj. Duphalac, I/V fluids and other supportive treatment.

Procedure: Fracture shaft tibia - IM IL nailing + Fracture medial mallels fixation done on 2.4.17

Surgeon: Dr. Y. Deshmukh; Anesthetist: Dr. Manisha Pakhmode

Hospital Stay: Patient was admitted with above mentioned complaints and history. Admission MLC sent to P.S. Dhantoli, MLC no 223/17 on 31.03.17. Patient investigated hematologically and radiologically were done. X - ray right leg AP and lateral done S/o - fracture right shaft of tibia. Hence sought by orthopedician Dr. Y. Deshmukh sir and he advice surgery on 02.04.17 1 ml nailing + fracture medial molecular fixation done ↓ SA successfully. Post operative patient managed conservatively with above mentioned given treatment. Patient responded well to then given treatment. Now patient in stable hence patient is being discharge with vitally stable condition.

On Discharge Treatment : GC - moderate, afebrile, BP - 120/80 mmHg, P - 86/min, Spo2 - 98% on RA, R/S - clear, CVS - S1 S2 (N), P/A - soft, CNS - conscious oriented, moving all 4 limbs, pupils - equal R2L.


