16. Position of limbs— Especially of arms and of fingers in suspected drowning the presence or absence of sand or earth within the nails or on the skin of hands and feet. Upper Limbs – semiflexed. Lower limbs – semi flexed.

17. Surface wounds and injuries Their nature, position, dimensions (measured) and directions to be accurately stated- their probable age and cause to be noted. If bruises be present what is the condition of the subcutaneous tissues? 1) laceration present over right side of forehead of size 6cmx2cmx bone deep. Underlying fissure fracture of temporal bone of size 6cmx0.3cm with surrounding ti haematoma presents. 2) laceration present over right side of face extending from medial canthus of right eye running downward oblique towards right ear of size 9cmx1cmx muscle deep. 3) graze abrasion present over dorsal aspect of left elbow size 8cmx4cm red in colour. 4) laceration present over antero-medial aspect of right thigh of size 3cmx2cmx muscle deep.
