If bruises be present what is the condition of the subcutaneous tissues ?

- 1 Contused abrasion of size 7x4 cm present over left parieto-occipital region , red in colour
- 2 Abrasion of size 2x1 cm present over posterior aspect of right shoulder , red in colour
- 3 Abrasion of size 3x1 cm present over right side of back in its upper 1/3 rd part , 4 cm medial to injury no 2 , red in colour .
- 4 Abrasion of size 5x1 cm present over posterior aspect of left leg in its middle 1/3 rd part , red in colour .
- 5 Abrasion of size 2x1 cm present over lateral aspect of left knee , red in colour .
- 6 Multiple Abrasion of size ranges from 1x1 cm to 1x0.5 cm present over anterior aspect of right thigh in its lower 1/3 rd part , red in colour .
- 7 Abrasion of size 3x0.5 cm present over antero-medial aspect of right leg in its upper 1/3 rd part , red in colour .
- 8 Abrasion of size 2 x 0.5 cm present over antero-medial aspect of right leg in its middle 1/3 rd part , red in colour .
