Opinion as to AGE OF INJURY:-

- > All the examined injuries are ~ 2 TO 3 days old (presence of reddish brown scab)

Opinion (medical) as to TYPE OF INJURY:-

- > Injury no. 1 is of **GRIEVOUS** type (गंभीर स्वरूपाची)
- > Injury no. 2 is of **SIMPLE** type (साधारण स्वरूपाची)

Opinion as to causative factor (KIND OF FORCE / WEAPON):-

- > All the injuries are possible due to high velocity **HARD and BLUNT impact**


Opinion as to THE MANNER OF INJURY:-

- > Possibility that the examined injuries are caused in the manner as documented in the admission notes cannot be ruled out.

- ❖ I have examined the above-mentioned patient for medicolegal purpose & the injury report has been prepared by me from the Indoor case Record of the patient, after taking into consideration the injuries present over the pts body at the time of admission, the documentary evaluation of the Treating Consultants involved in the case & the Radiological Investigation Reports
- ❖ The reports & original films of all the post-traumatic radiological investigations (X-rays / CT Scan etc) done are handed over to patient at the time of discharge with their acknowledgement.
