



**Internal Examination: -**

**19. Head: -**

Injuries under the scalp, their nature.

Underscalp contusion of size 6cm x 4cm, dark red noted over the right frontal region of the scalp. Underscalp contusion of size 10cm x 8cm, dark red noted over the right parieto-temporal region and corresponds with injury no 1 as mentioned in column 17.

Skull- Vault and base- describe fractures, their sites, dimensions, directions, etc.

Evidence of craniotomy noted over the right temporal region. Skull bone over the right temporal region absent over an area of 6cm x 3cm.

Brain- The appearance of its coverings, size, weight and general condition of the organ itself and any abnormality found in its examination to be carefully noted.

Meninges torn over an area of 4cm x 4cm in the right temporal region. Contusion of size 6cm x 5cm, dark red noted over the right temporal region of the brain matter. Subdural hematoma of size 14cm x 9cm, dark red containing 50cc of blood noted over the right fronto-parieto-temporal region. Subarachnoid hematoma noted diffusely over the entire right hemisphere. Necrotic zone along the contused area noted.

**20) Thorax: -**

Walls, Ribs, Cartilages.

Intact, no fracture noted.

Pleura

Intact.

Larynx, Trachea and Bronchi

Intact, no foreign body. Thyroid and hyoid intact.

Right Lung

Left Lung

Both lungs intact, edematous, congested.

Pericardium

Intact.

Heart and weight

Heart intact. Chambers empty. Valves intact. Coronaries patent. No abnormality noted.
